### 57th Annual Roger H. Corbetta Awards Program

**CIB AWARDS** are presented for projects that exemplify excellence in concrete in their architectural design, engineering design, general construction, and workmanship, either individually or in combination.

### ACI Excellence in Concrete Construction Awards

CIB, as an ACI chapter, can submit up to two projects each year, from those awarded by CIB, to ACI for entry into their international award program. In 2017, a submitted project won second place for mid-rise buildings. **Your project could have international recognition.** Go to [www.ACIExcelsence.org](http://www.ACIExcelsence.org) for more information.

### Eligibility

Any type of structures (i.e. foundation, building, infrastructure (tunnel, bridge, highway, roadways, water/wastewater), or new innovative use) that uses concrete as its primary building material is eligible for consideration for an award.

Construction of the concrete structure must be substantially complete by June 2018. There is no limit to the number of entries that can be submitted by an individual or firm. The projects entered must be located in one of the five boroughs of New York City, Westchester County, and Long Island.

CIB members also have the option of submitting projects from outside of the metropolitan New York area, but awards will be limited to one out of area and/or one out of country award.

Entries are accepted from non-members but the projects entered must be in one of the five boroughs of New York City, Westchester County, or Long Island.

### Categories

Awards will be granted in one of the following categories. Awards will not necessarily be awarded in each category.

- Low-Rise buildings – up to 3 stories including residential, schools, commercial, industrial, etc.
- Mid-Rise buildings – 4 to 15 stories
- High-Rise buildings – over 15 stories
- Infrastructure – bridges, site structures, water resource structures, marine structures, airports, etc.
- Repair and Restoration
- Decorative Concrete – exterior & interior finishes, ornamentation, hardscapes, etc.

### Submission

Entrants will be required to submit written descriptions of the project and use and special features of the concrete used in the project. Contact CIB to express interest in submitting a project and an entry package explaining the submission requirements will be sent.

### Judging

An awards jury consisting of CIB members representing design, construction and materials will evaluate entries on the following:

- Architectural merit
- Engineering merit
- Creativity
- Innovative construction techniques or solutions
- Innovative use of concrete
- Ingenuity
- Sustainability and resilience
- Functionality and end use suitability
